ASIST is open to anyone interested in learning about suicide prevention. Developed by LivingWorks, the two-day workshop will help you become a more comfortable, confident and competent caregiver. CEUs are available for licensed professionals. For those wanting to commit to regular weekly volunteering on our hotline, the fee is waived. Age minimum is 16 years old. Hotline volunteering requires additional training.

- The workshop includes lunch on Saturday and dinner on Sunday. **If you have specific food allergies, dietary needs or accomodations, please contact us at least 2 weeks in advance.**
- The training includes workshop materials, certification, and can count toward CEUs for counselors and social workers. The cost of the workshop also helps fund the training of our phone volunteers, whose commitment helps to save lives.
- Cost: \$195 Standard Fee - \$100 Student Fee – Free for Hotline Volunteers in Training
